Eco-engineering to help coastal cities fight the effects of climate change

Delegates gathered at the Global Estuaries Forum in Deauville, France, last week heard a host of examples from around the world where developers and city planners are using natural engineering to reduce flood risks and improve water quality in coastal cities.

Examples of the eco-engineering case studies discussed included the Netherlands, where Willow Forests have been planted along the coast in place of conventional levees, creating a natural barrier that will dissipate damaging waves in the event of storm surges.
