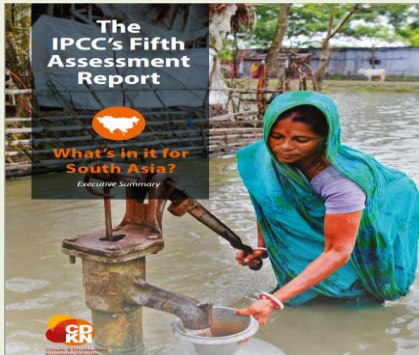

The IPCC's Fifth Assessment report: What's in it for South Asia

Recent heavy losses from extreme weather suggest that current strategies are unable to deal with existing climatic threats. The report suggests several potential mitigation strategies. Ecosystem management is highlighted as a key approach to mitigating the effects of climate change, particularly through sustainable watershed management.
