Second Arab Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction

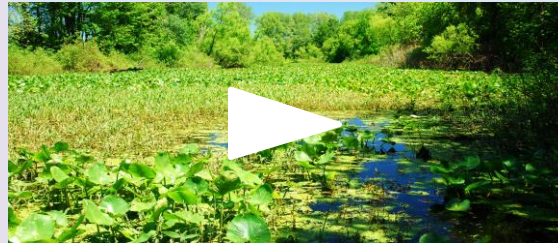
