This report presents the recommendations of the Least Developed Countries group regarding the development of an institutional framework to address loss and damage, as part of the UN climate change negotiations. It calls for: mitigation ambition to be ramped up; bigger support for adaptation; residual loss and damage to be tackled; enabled institutional framework that has a risk management component and should be validated by COP20.

Digital Observatory for Protected Areas Explorer

Available in English, French, Spanish and Portuguese, DOPA Explorer Beta is the first web based tool documenting 9,000 marine and terrestrial protected areas that are greater than 150 km². It can help identify the protected areas with the most unique ecosystems, assess the pressures they are exposed to as a result of human development and provide ecological data derived from close to real-time earth observations.

Successful Climate Change Adaptation and Disaster Risk Reduction project by Government of Jamaica & UNEP

This EU-funded project aimed at building resilience of vulnerable coastal communities in Negril and local industries from climate change impacts recently closed in December 2013 and was marked by significant achievements in ecosystem-based DRR. Important Eco-DRR activities implemented through the project include seagrass replantation to slow down wave action and reduce beach erosion, mangrove plantation and agroforestry.
