#### **News** Sandy Grant Targets Storm Resilience

Rutgers University, New Jersey, has been awarded \$1.17 million for their participation in the Hurricane Sandy Coastal Resiliency Competitive Grant Program. The funds will be used to help 54 flood-prone towns in the Raritan River basin, NJ, to protect their ecosystems and use ecosystems to mitigate floods.

Green infrastructure will be used to replace impervious surfaces in at- risk communities, serving to reduce stormwater runoff in addition to providing other environmental benefits such as carbon sequestration.
