As part of the 3rd Understanding Risk Forum, recently held in London, UK, the Nature Conservancy organized a session on "The role of ecosystems in reducing risk – advances and opportunities in risk assessment and risk management". The session presented recent advances in quantifying and modelling the risk reduction potential of coastal ecosystems with respect to coastal hazards, as well as tools utilized to integrate ecosystem information in risk assessment and risk management planning and decision making. Two of the key speakers were

from well-known engineering companies, Deltares and IH Cantabria, which highlighted the importance of coastal ecosystems for DRR.
