PEDRR SHOUTOUT : PEDRR Side Event at the 5th International Disaster Risk Conference (IDRC) in Davos, Switzerland

From August 24-28th, the 5th international disaster risk conference will be held in Davos, Switzerland. On Tuesday, August 26th, PEDRR will conduct a panel discussion on ecosystem management approaches for integrating both disaster risk reduction (DRR) and climate change (CCA) adaptation. It will draw from field projects and identify lessons on how best to integrate DRR and CCA through ecosystem-based solutions. The panel will discuss key considerations for designing ecosystem-based DRR/CCA projects and applying them into practice. IUCN will also conduct their own side event on Wednesday, August 27th, regarding the opportunities and challenges of implementing Ecosystem-based Disaster Risk Reduction.
