The IPCC's Fifth Assessment: What's in it for Small Island Developing States (SIDS)?

This publication highlights general findings from the IPCC's Fifth Assessment Report on climate change adaptation (CCA) and mitigation which are of particular relevance to SIDS. Conserving ecosystem services which provide storm surge protection in addition to 'hard' solutions including building sea walls and surge barriers is one CCA key measure in these areas. However coastal ecosystems are also threatened, sea level rise is reported as the most significant climate change threat to the survival of mangroves, serving a host of commercial and subsistence uses.
