Reporting back from the 1st Asia Parks Congress and the 9th Pacific Islands Conference



After the devastation following the 2011 Great East Earthquake/Tsunami, the Government of Japan decided to establish the Sanriku Reconstruction National Park which will run along the entire affected coastline, to serve as a green buffer zone for added protection against coastal hazards. IUCN and the Ministry of Environment of Japan organized several key discussion events at the **Asia Parks Congress** in November 2013, focusing on the role of protected areas in disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation. Outcomes from these discussions will feed into the World Parks Congress, in November 2014, in Sydney. IUCN also participated in the **9th Pacific Islands Conference on Nature Conservation and Protected Areas**, in December 2013, and gave a presentation on PEDRR. The need for an integrated approach to climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and sustainable development in the Pacific emerged as a key issue at the Conference
