UN sets the stage for the adoption of a new global agreement on disaster risk

By confirming that the third World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction will take place in Sendai, Japan in 2015, the United Nations General Assembly has set the stage for the roll out of a new agreement on disaster risk. The main agenda for the conference, that's due to take place from 14th-18th March, is the adoption of a successor to the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA). The HFA is a 10-year plan, that combines expert knowledge and practice from different sectors and actors with a view to reducing disaster risk worldwide.

A new paper published by United Nations University's Institute for Environment and Human Security, in the International Journal of Disaster Risk Reduction, examines the role of ecosystem-based solutions for combating heat waves in Cologne area of Germany. The objective of this study was to assess the vulnerability of the Cologne urban population to heat waves, taking into consideration a range of social and ecological variables.
